Victim Service Report:

HUGS allocated \$18,807 for victim services. These expenses included funds for rent, day care, cars, car insurance and gift cards for food, gas and sundries.

Treasurer's Report

The total receipts for the year were \$47,768. These receipts include funds raised from the Walk which totaled \$20,741. and \$2,635. for the Mother's Day Project, \$14,145. Flavors of the World Fundraiser, \$5673. raised through a residential mailing campaign and the balance included other fundraisers and misc.donations.

The total expenses were \$54,331. These expenses included \$18,807. for victim services, \$8,000. to the Easton Recreation Department to support the homework club and late bus. A total of 7 Grants were awarded to community applicants totaling \$8549. We also awarded two \$500. scholarships. We sponsored the YMCA summer camp program and Easton Recreation Summer programs which was a total of \$3000. Also, \$1,942. for the Mother's Day Project. \$4,284. for walk expenses, \$3556. for residential mailing expenses The balance of the expenses were for operating expenses and other miscellaneous expenses.
